

INFANT TODDLER BARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES

Early Intervention Services are at no cost to families. The services are designed to meet the needs of families with a child under the age of three to help overcome or diminish delays. Early childhood special education teachers, therapists and service coordinators work together with a Primary Provider to meet the needs of your family. We will assess skill levels & provide intervention in five developmental domains: speech & language, fine & gross motor, cognitive, self-help & social emotional skills (including relational, behavioral & autism precursors), as we assist you with functional activities for your child.

INDIVIDUALIZED PROGRAMS

are developed with an Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP), designed to target the strengths and needs of the child and the family. The child's individual needs, along with the family's choice, help to determine the selection of services.

YOUR CHILD'S NATURAL ENVIRONMENT

A natural environment is the best place for early intervention services to be provided. Our staff will come to your home, your child's day care provider or to a community location of your choice to provide services.

SCREENINGS & EVALUATIONS

Screenings are held for: Hearing & Vision plus Development in Cognitive, Social Emotional, Language, Self-Help & Gross & Fine Motor Skills. We also come to your home for evaluations to see if your child is developing as needed.


