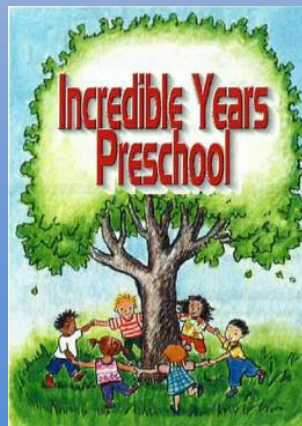

INFANT TODDLER EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES (BIRTH – AGE 3)

Early intervention services are provided at no cost to families in our service area (Barton, Rice, Stafford, Pawnee, and Rush counties). These services are designed to meet the needs of families with a child under the age of three that has a delay(s) and/or has been diagnosed with a disability. Our goal is to help overcome or lessen delays before your child turns 3 years old and starts preschool.

Our team is made up of early childhood special education teachers, speech language pathologists, physical therapists, and a Spanish translator.

We assess skills and provide intervention in six developmental areas:

- fine motor
- gross motor
- adaptive (self help)
- cognitive
- social-communication
- social/social-emotional skills

As a part of our evaluation we also screen hearing and vision.

by evaluation findings, observation, and parent/caregiver report

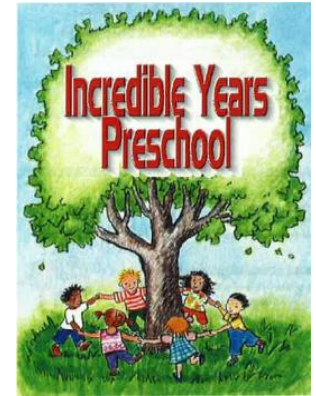


Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP)
is developed if child is eligible for services.
The child's needs and family goals will determine what services will be provided.



A primary service provider provides services in the child's natural environment.
The evidence-based coaching model is used allowing the family to have one consistent provider who collaborates with the rest of the team to meet the family's needs.
